Saturday School High Achievement Scholarship Program Guidelines

PURPOSE

The Saturday School High Achievement Scholarship Program rewards high school seniors who show evidence of high academic achievement.

AWARDS SELECTION CRITERIA

Seniors who participated in Saturday School as a student or provided consistent, quality service as a volunteer at Saturday School are eligible to apply for the competitive award.

Applications will be evaluated according to the objectives of the scholarship program listed below. Each applicant must:

- Be a high school senior in Montgomery County
- Have enrolled and attended a minimum of 12 sessions during the current school year OR served as a volunteer at Saturday School for at least 35 sessions from grades 7 through 12
- Have a grade point average of 3.0 or higher
- Provide:
 - A copy of the first semester transcript
 - Proof of a score 1000 or higher on the SAT; a score of 20 or higher on the ACT.
 - Two letters of recommendation (excluding the Center Director at your site)
 - A letter of acceptance from an accredited college or university

APPLICATION DEADLINE

Applications must be completed and submitted to the Center Director no later than April 22, 2017. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Awards will be announced at the Saturday School Closing Ceremonies in May.
